

Building Bricks

Architects and Engineers have worked together to create Cincinnati's most iconic landmarks. Architects, like designers, create the overall form of a building. Engineers are tasked with the mechanics of how to make an architect's "form" come to life.

Materials:

Building Bricks (1 set for each player)

2 People

1. Assign one person as the Architect and one person as the Engineer. Each player should have their own set of building bricks.
2. Both players should sit back to back.
3. The Architect will use their building bricks to build something first, without the Engineer peeking.
4. Once the Architect finishes, they will describe how to build a replica to the Engineer.
5. The Architect should use directional phrases (put one red 2x2 brick on top of a blue 2x4 brick) to navigate the Engineer.
6. The Engineer should reveal their completed build to the Architect.
